He has received CCST(Eqv.) from Specialist Training Authority of Medical Royal Colleges (UK) and FRCP(London). He is also an advisor for Royal College of Physicians (London) and has been invited to present his research and lecture at several international meetings in the USA, Canada, Japan, Australia, Thailand, Morocco, Malaysia, Cameroon and Bhutan.
